wanted to cancel his contract we disagree with julian s assessment of the book we believe it explains both the man and his work underlining his commitment to the truth julian always claimed the book was well written we agree and this also encouraged us to make the book available to readers and the contract by the time julian wanted to cancel the deal he had already used the advance money to settle his legal bills so the contract still stands we have decided to honour it and to publish this book is the unauthorised first draft it is passionate provocative and opinionated like its author it fulfils the promise of the original proposal and we are proud to publish it canongate books september 2011
